







NUMBER OF LOCAL RESEARCH PAPERS, BY PROJECT: 1979-2013







Figure 7: Pictured is the house at 9 Stoney Court. Note the different house sidings (stone, brick, and regular), the peaked rooftops, and the spacious front yard.

Figure 10: This is a tower that has been across from the Beverage residence for over two years. Its purpose is to record wind speeds in order to find out the best locations for wind turbines.






Figure 11: WIND TURBINES WITHIN AND AROUND THE STUDY SECTION (Souece: Invenergy)








Doing Geography Problem: Graph showing number of riders and possessions at times along the "Brown F" route.





Old North Normal Project: Locational Map showing 611 Normal Avenue residence relative to ISU campus and surrounding streets.











Photo of William Walters from dustjacket of his book *The Heart of the Cornbelt: An Illustrated History of Corn Farming in McLean County* (1997)


